

If you have problems with the BRAIN and Vista:

In IAR workbench:

1. Right click the project heading ('Wizard – Debug') in the workspace browser
2. Go to Properties
3. On the dialog that pops up, there is a list on the left, go to 'C/C++ Compiler'
 1. Go to the 'Precompiler' tab
 2. Under *additional include directories*
 1. add '/Program Files (x86)/Best/Brain/Includes'
4. In the list on the left, select 'Linker'
 1. Under *additional library directories*
 1. add '/Program Files (x86)/Best/Brain/Includes'
5. Click 'Apply' and close the options dialog

The main thing is to add a path for where Vista installs the software which is 'Program Files (x86)' instead of 'Program Files'. The instructions tell them to add a new line instead of modifying the existing line. This is done so they don't have problems if they decide to then open the project on another machine.
